- Possibility to do family and dyad work.
- Caseload of 5-10 individual clients.
- Co-facilitate group therapy on and off-site, depending on current programming with outside agencies.
- Attend weekly staff meetings and case presentations. Meetings are Thursdays 11:30 - 1:00.
- Attend in-house trainings
- Invited to attend any CE trainings that we offer to the public.
- Receive weekly one-on-one clinical supervision
- Opportunity to develop own group program to promote as part of the practice in the Spring term.
